We are going to ask you to bring down your Costumes for all to see... We will be giving you details of the numbers you are in and the costumes you require to supply yourself!?

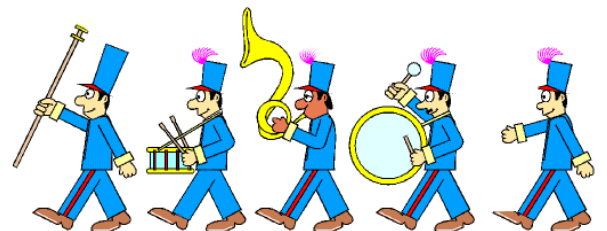
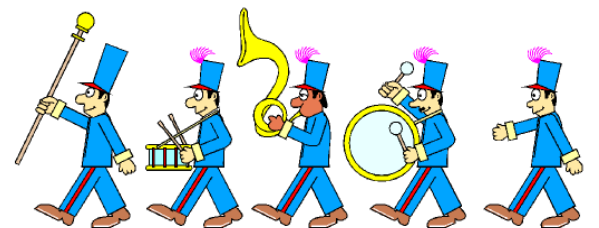
This will be after half term! So get your costumes ready now!

Can I remind you that all Scouting members of the cast need to be in the New Scout Uniform with Blue Trousers or Combats and All guiding members of the cast will be in their appropriate section top and blue trousers, skirt, culottes or combats. PLEASE! Lets look *uniform* on the stage.

Some Theatre Back Stage Rules.

- All members of the cast will be split into two dressing rooms. Boys and Girls!
- There will be Matrons in those rooms looking after you and the room! You will be able to hear you in the stage from the dressing rooms if you are very noisy. Keep the noise down when in the dressing rooms
- YOU MUST ARRIVE AND LEAVE THE THEATRE IN UNIFORM! This is very important!
- The stage door at the side of the theatre will be open for you to gain entrance. You must 'sign in' in your dressing room and then get yourself ready.
- You must not go into the front of house before the show starts.
