Stuff you need to know!

Don't forget you will need a towel for when you get washed. Please use "roll on" not aerosol antiperspirants.

Personal Possessions

We are not insured for your personal possessions and the responsibility for these remains your own.

PLEASE LEAVE ALL JEWELLERY, WATCHES AND VALUABLES AT HOME.

Jewellery catches the light so please remove all rings, earrings etc. before reaching the Theatre. They may be at risk if you leave them Backstage.

You will need

1. Your name on everything
2. Baby wipes or lotion and tissues to remove make up (make up must be removed before leaving the theatre) – the make up used can easily be removed with soap and water. An OLD towel is essential.
- 3 At least 3 coat hangers.

BOYS! Remember. Traditional swimming trunks, briefs or "y" style underwear for under your costume, in white or a pale shade, not visible beneath white or light clothing.

Show Week

For all shows during show week **please arrive at the theatre in full uniform.**

Always enter by the Stage Door. **NOT** through the main forum entrance and **register immediately** you set foot in the Theatre.

Meet at the theatre at 6pm

Tuesday 27th November – Night off and rest (we will only call a number that needs work)

Wednesday Friday 28th – 30th November – Arrive at theatre at 6pm show will start at 7pm

Saturday 1st December – Arrive at the theatre at 1pm for the show to start at 2pm. between the matinee and evening performance you will be taken to the Friarage hospital for food and refreshments before the final performance at 7pm

Each evening performance should aim to finish just after 9pm.

All headmasters have been informed about your involvement in the show.

Parents – We need you!

We need help to iron costumes at the Forum on Sunday afternoon during the rehearsal.

Parents are respectfully asked to wait outside the Stage Door when collecting children. Similarly we cannot accommodate parents at the Dress Rehearsal.

YOUR SAFETY

We must ask you to be careful at all times, especially Backstage.

Scenery and Rostra are very heavy. Keep out of the way and watch your heads

Lights get very HOT and cables are easily TRIPPED over.

PLEASE follow instructions given to you by the Backstage crew. If they ask you to MOVE then MOVE now!!

Watch out for curtains at the end of your performance, move out of their way and NEVER peep through them at any time.

THERE WILL BE A FIRE DRILL DURING DRESS REHEARSAL

- You must "check in" and "check out" at the Stage Door
- Absolutely NO mobile phones (They cause interference)
- Don't bring valuables (i.e. watches, cameras etc)
