We will walk on mass back to the Forum at 6pm to get ready for the evening performance. The Saturday evening performance will end slightly later than all the other.

**We are aiming to finish each evening performance at approximately 9.15pm**

**There will be drinks provided during the show week. (TEA/COFFEE/ORANGE JUICE) It is important that you bring along a mug/cup with your name on at the Technical rehearsal on the 15<sup>th</sup> and leave it for the week.**
