## Rehearsal Etiquette

- Please be there on time so that we can make a prompt start;
- If you are unable to attend, please let us know by e-mail beforehand ([registrar@northallertongangshow.org.uk](mailto:registrar@northallertongangshow.org.uk)) or by ringing the number below at the time of the rehearsal.
- Attend all rehearsals  
– if you are not there you will be taken out of the items(s) after missing rehearsals on three occasions;
- Listen carefully to instructions and keep an eye on the conductor;
- Keep silent when you are waiting and others are rehearsing  
– why not spend time reading through your parts or bring something to do.
- Make sure that you keep well hydrated.  
Drink plenty of water or squash.
- Bring your dance shoes.
- Leave your mobile phone at home,  
Like all Scouting activities, mobiles are not permitted;
- Taking of photographs at rehearsals or posting of images other than on the official site ([www.northallertongangshow.org.uk](http://www.northallertongangshow.org.uk)) is strictly prohibited.

**You must arrive at all rehearsals in full uniform as appropriate to your section.**

<p><b>1E. From Easingwold</b> North on the A19 towards Thirsk. At Thirsk follow A19 Teesside.</p> <p>Now follow Instruction 2</p>	<p><b>1H. From Harrogate</b> take the A59 to <b>Knaresborough</b> and on to the A1 northbound. Leave the A1 at Dishforth on the A168 towards Teesside.</p> <p>Now follow Instruction 2</p>	<p><b>1N. From Northallerton</b> take the A684 to Ellerbeck and join the A19 Northbound towards Teesside.</p> <p>Now Follow instruction 2</p>
<p><b>1S. From Scarborough</b> Take the A170 to pickering and on the Thirsk. Join the A19 Northbound towards Teesside.</p> <p>Now Follow instruction 2</p>	<p><b>1T. From Thirsk</b> take A19 northbound towards Teesside.</p> <p>Now follow Instruction 2</p>	<p><b>1Y. From York</b>, North on the A19 past Easingwold and on to Thirsk. At Thirsk follow A19 Teesside.</p> <p>Now follow Instruction 2</p>
<p><b>1Rpn. From Ripon</b> take the A6108 to join the A168 northbound to the A19 towards Teesside.</p> <p>Now follow Instruction 2</p>	<p><b>1Rnd. From Richmond</b> Head through Brompton-on-Swale and on to Northallerton.</p> <p>Now follow instruction 1N.</p>	<p><b>1L. From Stokesley</b> Head South on the A172 towards Northallerton and the A19.</p> <p>Now follow instruction 3</p>
<p>2. Leave the A19 on the A172 signed to Stokesley.</p>		<p>3. Turn off the A172 signed to Carlton-in-Cleveland.</p>
<p>4. In Carlton take the left fork over the bridge to the higher road on the right. (If you get as far as the Pub on the left you have just missed the turn).</p> 	<p>6. The Watson Centre is the last house at the end of the terrace.</p> 	
<p>7. Parking available up the side of the centre.</p> 	<p>8. To avoid congestion, please turn right from the centre and leave via the ford.</p> 	
<p>Please park as far up the car park as you can. This then allows other people to enter.</p> <p><b>Please do not park on the road-side as the parking bays belong to the cottages.</b></p>
