The **Cooking Skills** work has continued with quiches, jams and cakes.

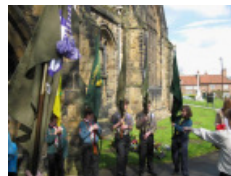


All the Y.L.s from the unit with training still to complete attended the **County Young Leader Weekend** in April
