Following the collection at the District Carol Service, we were able to donate £34 to **Hambleton Foodshare** (the Northallerton Food Bank).

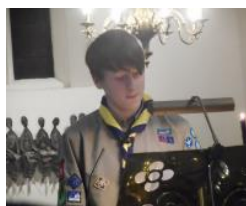
We also sent £34 to Action for Children.
