Chocolate Cake Recipe

Ingredients

7oz self raising flour, 1 oz sieved cocoa, 2 eggs, 4oz soft margarine, 8oz caster sugar, 5 tablespoons evaporated milk, 5 tablespoons cold water.

Method

Mix all ingredients thoroughly together. Divide mixture into 2 greased and lined 8inch sandwich tins. Bake in oven 350°F, 180°C, Gas mark 4 for 30-35 minutes. Allow to cool and sandwich cakes together with chocolate icing (recipe below).

Chocolate filing. 1½oz margarine, 1½ level tbsp cocoa, 1½ tbsp evaporated milk, 6 oz icing sugar. Melt the margarine and stir in the cocoa thoroughly. Remove from the heat and beat in the icing sugar and evaporated milk. Allow to cool before using.
