1. Scouts and Explorer Scouts wishing to be considered for a place must have been born no earlier than the 25th July 1993 and no later than 27th July 1997.
2. The total cost to each young person is expected to be in the region of £2000 each and is the responsibility of the young person to find this money. The first payment of £250 per person will be due at the end of February 2010.
3. The application forms* will be available early to mid October and these MUST be returned to Simon Hickling (DC) No Later than 8th November. They do NOT go back to County.
