## Getting to The Watson Scout Centre

1. From Northallerton, take the A684 towards Ellerbeck and Teesside.
2. After Ellerbeck, turn left onto the A19 northbound.
3. After about a mile, leave the A19 to join the A172 towards Stokesley.
4. In five miles, turn right into Carlton.
6. Take the right fork over the bridge to the higher level road.  
(If you get to the Black Bull on the left, you have just missed the right fork)
7. The Watson Scout Centre is the stone cottage at the far end of terrace.
8. Turn right, up the side of the building to park.
