The Patronage Scheme was created for the mutual benefit of Gang Show and their most enthusiastic supporters.

Each Patron is entitled to 2 seats in a preferential block, at the performance of their choice. A Donation of £10 per patron is ask, this includes the price of the patrons ticket. Ticket Prices are £6 for adults and £3 for concessions and children under 14.

Patrons are also invited to visit a rehearsal, should they so wish. On normal performances Patrons will be met before the show and their order taken for complimentary interval drinks. During the interval, Patrons are shown to a special seating area where their refreshments will be waiting. The support of each Patron is acknowledged with a mention in the show programme.
